be contesting for the first time in assembly polls at the behest of party president Rahul Gandhi. This is significant development and it is a clear indication that Pilot's role would be vital if Congress forms government in Rajasthan.

Two-term former chief minister Gehlot and the party's state chief Pilot announced on Wednesday that they will contest the December 7 election.

"We both are contesting elections. Any other leader who wants to contest is most welcome," Gehlot said at a press conference.

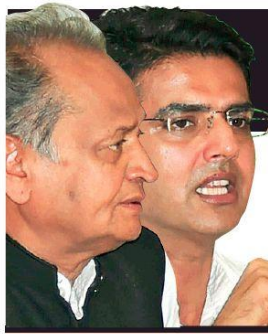
Pilot, on his part, acknowledged that he had decided to contest on the directions of party president Rahul Gandhi. "I have decided to contest the elections as per the instructions of Rahulji and on the request of Gehlotji. We are sure of the landslide victory of Congress in the upcoming elections," he said.

In Madhya Pradesh, on the other hand, the party has not fielded senior leaders Kamal Nath, Jyotiraditya Scindia and Digvijaya Singh for the assembly election scheduled for November 29.

While Ashok Gehlot is expected to contest from his home borough Sardarpura, Sachin Pilot's constituency has yet to be decided.

Gehlot has been representing Sardarpura in Jodhpur for four consecutive terms while Pilot was Lok Sabha member twice, once each from Dausa and Ajmer, before he lost the 2014 election from Ajmer.

"Pilot, a Gujjar, may contest from Gujjar dominated constituencies. These include Masuda (Ajmer), Nagar (Bharatpur), Nasirabad (Ajmer) or Viratnagar (Jaipur). Being the state chief, Pilot can choose any of the safe seats," said a senior Congress leader, who did not wish to be identified.



## BJP MP Harish Meena's Entry into Cong to Help Balance Caste Equation



JAIPUR: In a major setback to the BJP, its Lok Sabha member from Dausa and former top cop of Rajasthan Harish Meena has left the party to join the Congress. In 2014 election, he had defeated his elder brother and former Union minister of state in Manmohan Singh government Namo Narain Meena, who came third in the contest.

Kirodi Lal Meena, who was the runner-up in the 2014 battle of "Meena supremacy" said there will be no impact of Harish Meena joining the Congress.

"Harish Meena was in Congress earlier. People know that he is an opportunist. He joined the BJP to become an MP and now he has left the party," said Kirodi Lal Meena, who joined the BJP early this year and is now a Rajya Sabha member. Meena's induction in BJP is likely to help the party balance the caste equation between Gujjars and Meena considering Pilot, one of the party's chief ministerial candidates, is contesting the election.—ops

Kharasia: "No constituency is anyone's den — it is the public's den. My track record will win people's hearts here, and I will win." OP Chaudhary (57), former IAS officer and Raipur collector-turned-politician, told ET. He is trying to win Kharasia for the BJP — a seat which the party has not won in 70 years. Even the party's late leader Dileep Singh Judeo could not win this seat in 1988 against the then Congress CM Arjun Singh in a bypoll.

The battle of Kharasia, among the most high-profile ones in Phase-2 of Chhattisgarh elections, has become a matter of pride for BJP. Chaudhary joined the party a few months ago in Delhi in the presence of BJP president Amit Shah, chief minister Ramnath Kovind and Congress state president Nand Kumar Patel, who was the MLA from Kharasia from 1990 till 2013. He was killed in a Maoist attack in Jheeram Valley. Umesh won the

Rahul Gandhi held a big rally for Umesh here on Tuesday and the Congress is upset. Chaudhary says he has a masterplan ready for a "Naya (New) Kharasia". When asked by ET about why people would opt for him and not Nand Kumar Patel's legacy as earlier, he said: "At the end of the day, people want a better future and development." "I will bring education facilities here like I turned around

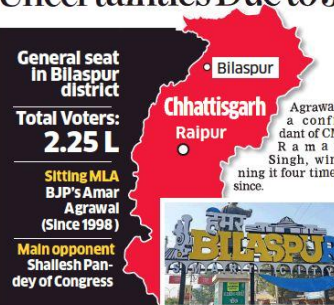
Dantewada as a collector," he told ET. The road is tough for BJP though and Chaudhary in his public speeches, avoids attacking the Patel family so as not to hurt the sensitivities of the people. "Our politics is not against an individual but for better future of this area. I promise a polytechnic, an ITI, a nursing college, a good quality hospital," he said at a rally on Wednesday. BJP leaders have been highlighting Chaudhary's "sacrifice" in giving up his IAS career to serve Kharasia. Chaudhary is also playing the home-boy card — he belongs to Nichepura village here and grew up the hard way after his father passed away when he was young.

Both Chaudhary and Umesh belong to the same caste, a major voter base here. At Nandeli House, the ancestral home of the Patel family, Umesh Patel still does not sit on his father's chair but on a sofa as he attends to people for most of the day when he is not campaigning. A number of locals told ET that Nandeli House is "approachable and work gets done if we go there". Chaudhary says the Ramnath Singh government "has tried enough in the last 15 years, but the local leadership of the Congress has been inactive on development".
